Home School Agreement-Covid-19

As a school we will:	As a parent I will:	As a pupil I will try to:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow and implement the guidance from the Government and Public Health England. • Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 infection. • Ensure that pupils, staff and other adults do not come into the school if they have Covid-19 symptoms. Send home those who develop symptoms immediately. • Implement enhanced cleaning procedures, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often. • Build frequent hand washing regimes into the school day, and support children with good respiratory and hand hygiene • Provide hand sanitisers in all classrooms • Put in place measures to reduce contacts and maximise distancing between those in school wherever possible and minimise potential for contamination so far as is reasonably practicable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I will send my child to school regularly unless they are displaying any of the symptoms of Covid-19. • I will engage with the NHS Test and Trace process. • If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not send them to school and self isolate for 14 days or until we receive a negative test result. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone. • If my child develops symptoms of Covid-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. • When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will follow the drop off and pick up protocols and timings, including adhering to the 2 metre social distancing rules and ensuring all children are hand held. • My child will only bring to school a water 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay 2m away from other people as I walk to school and enter the school grounds. • Follow the drop off and pick up rules. • Come into school calmly from my classroom entrance, use the hand sanitiser and follow the daily routines. • Tell an adult if I feel unwell. • Only bring into school the things my teacher has told me to. Leave everything else at home. • Use only my equipment and not share my equipment with others. • Stay in the right place at the right time and not entering areas that are out of bounds.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put in place measures to facilitate social distancing at school drop off and pick. • Minimise access to school • Where necessary wear appropriate PPE • Monitor and support regular school attendance through our normal attendance protocols • Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that supports your child, including their well-being and mental health. • Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as upholding additional expectations as set out in the Covid-19 Behaviour Appendix. • Communicate between home and school through email, Tapestry, the school website and Parentmail. • Continue to provide quality remote home learning in the event of school closure or for groups of children required to isolate on clinical or public health advice. • Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of Covid-19. • Inform you if there is a confirmed case of Covid-19 in your child's bubble and implement 14 day self isolation procedures. • Engage with NHS Test and Trace. • Work with the Health Protection Team in the event of a confirmed case in the school, an outbreak or a spike in the local area. 	<p>bottle, pencil case, sun hat/Winter hat, coat, lunch box (if required), PE kit, book bag and any other item specified by their teacher.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I will ensure my child has all the correct equipment they need including full school uniform. • I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully. • My child will know how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene. • I will not enter the school classrooms. • I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home. • I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details. • If my child's behaviour is repeatedly deemed unsafe to the health and safety of others, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. • I will support my child to complete the home learning set in the event of school closure or self isolation of my child's bubble. • I will support the school in their efforts to create an environment which is as safe as possible during this crisis. • We, as a family, will continue to follow government guidelines and uphold strict social distancing measures at all times to reduce the risk of bringing the infection into school. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play and work only with the children in my bubble. • Respect the personal space of other children and behave kindly towards others. • Stay in my seat during lessons [Year 1 and Year 2] • Use tissues for coughs and sneezes or sneeze/cough into my elbow. Put tissues in the bin as soon as I have used them. • Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others. • Wash my hands well using soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser. • Following the correct routes around the school and following the rules about only two children in the cloakroom at a time. • Tell an adult if I feel worried about anything. • Following all rules and instructions at all times so we are all safe. • Completing the home learning if I am not able to come to school.
