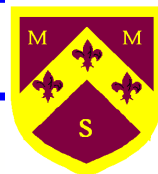

Key Vocabulary

Sketch- a rough drawing representing the chief features of an object or scene.

Observation- look closely at detail and recreate in drawing.

Pastels- chalk/oil, used to create texture, which can be blended.

Printing- impressing letters, characters or figures onto paper or cloth.

Paper sculpture - combining different types of paper to make a model.

Collage- art made by sticking different materials to a backing.

- Draw **detailed drawings** of leaves and squashes in **sketchbooks**.
- Observe and talk about 'Autumn' paintings by **famous artists**.
- Use **pastels and pencils** to match Autumn colours.
- Use **printing materials** to create Quickprint tiles of leaves to make **patterns**.
- Make **paper leaves** for a **sculpture**.
- Paint vegetable skins to show different **textures** in the style of Cezanne.
