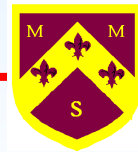

Key Content

There are many **potential dangers** both inside and outside the home.

It is important to assess risks to **prevent** and **avoid** accidents.

It is important to learn basic **First Aid** as it can save lives.

In **emergency** situations we should remember our training, **stay calm** and **reassure** the injured person.

In an emergency we should call for adult help, including calling **999** if necessary. We must provide the **operator** with the information they need to know to help us.
