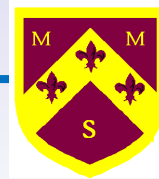

### Special Things



### Key Vocabulary

**Cross/Crucifix**—a symbol of Christianity. Jesus died on the Cross

**Bible**—The Christian Holy Book.

**Chalice**—the cup used for the wine in Holy Communion

**Paten**—the small plate used for the bread in Holy Communion

**Torah** Scrolls—the Jewish Holy Book written in the form of scrolls

**Tallit**—the prayer shawl worn by Jewish people

**Menorah**—a seven branch Hebrew candle made of Gold, which is important to Jewish people

**Yad**—special pointer used to read the Torah Scrolls

**Sacred**—of special religious importance.
