
Curriculum Enrichment Visits

Promoting active and healthy life styles.

Music instrumental lessons

Opportunities for pupils to learn to play the guitar, piano or take up singing, lessons.



Collaboration with Maids Moreton Hall Care Home.

In September 2018 we embarked on a collaborative project with Maids Moreton Hall Care Home in Maids Moreton. The project is designed to be mutually beneficial to both residents and children, promoting positive intergenerational social interaction. Examples include art workshops, pizza making, flower arranging, book sessions, carol singing, treasure hunts, Shrove Tuesday pancake tossing, seed planting and board games.
