About the role

Position 1 will include the delivering of phonics teaching and reading to groups of pupils, as directed by the class teacher, as well as supporting children in class in maths and other subjects. You will also take responsibility for delivering group interventions/individualised programmes of study, as directed by the class teacher. You will assist in monitoring pupils and assessing and recording their achievement and progress. You will promote the learning and personal development of pupils enabling them to make best use of the educational

opportunities available to them and to achieve their full potential. In addition, there will be some lunch supervision/mid morning break duties.

Position 2 is to provide 1:1 support for a 6 year old child with medical needs [Type 1 diabetes] during late mornings and lunch times. The role involves administering insulin, monitoring the child during lesson time, lunch time and play time and responding to changes in the child's blood glucose levels. Full training will be given.
