Understanding the World

- Find out how your favourite animal changes as it grows. Can you draw and label the life cycle?

- Use the internet to discover new facts about minibeasts.
- Make your own minibeast information book using words and pictures.

Creative

- Make a pebble minibeast by painting a smooth rock to look like an insect.
- Make a picture of a symmetrical butterfly.
- Learn a song about minibeasts to sing to your class.
