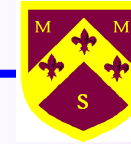

#### Key Vocabulary

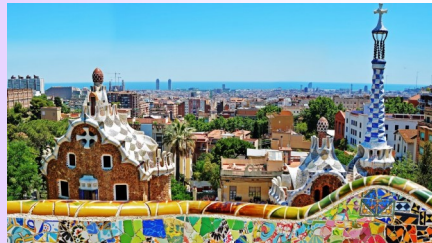
**Landscape** is the depiction of landscapes in art including natural scenery such as mountains, valleys, trees, rivers, and forests

**Perspective** is the skill of making some objects or people in a picture look further away than others.

**Layering:** using more than one layer of paint

**Mosaic** is a form of art where a surface is covered by small pieces of objects, like stones or tiles, that fit together tightly.

**Trencadis** is a technique used to cover structures with a mosaic of irregular pieces of ceramic, glass or marble tiles

Create a **mosaic collage** landscape using bright colour and pattern in the style of Metzinger

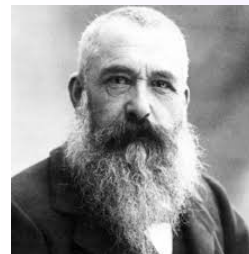
Make a mosaic animal using the Trencadis technique.

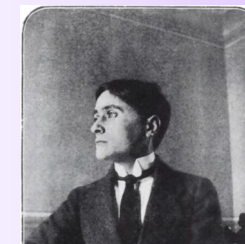
