Key Vocabulary

Landscape is the depiction of landscapes in art including natural scenery such as mountains, valleys, trees, rivers, and forests

Perspective is the skill of making some objects or people in a picture look further away than others.

Layering: using more than one layer of paint

Mosaic is a form of art where a surface is covered by small pieces of objects, like stones or tiles, that fit together tightly.

Trencadis is a technique used to cover structures with a mosaic of irregular pieces of ceramic, glass or marble tiles

Use a variety of tools and methods to create texture and perspective.


Create a mosaic collage landscape using bright colour and pattern in the style of Metzinger
