

Bodies



Key Vocabulary

Charcoal- a residue from heated wood used for sketching. Can be smudged for effect.

Body maquette- a scale model or draft of an unfinished sculpture.

Air drying clay- it dries naturally and does not need to be fired in a kiln.

Wire- an aluminium wire which bends but still holds its shape.

We will learn how to:


Draw **outlines** using felt tip pen in the style of **Julian Opie**.
