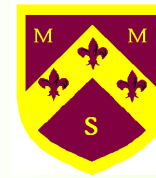

Fruit and Vegetables



Key Vocabulary

Sculpt-create or represent something by casting, carving or other shaping techniques

Clay-fine grained natural soil containing clay minerals

Charcoal-a residue from heated wood used for sketching. Can be smudged for effect.

Decorative-adding decoration to make something look better

Textile-a flexible material made by creating an interlocking network of yarns or threads

Softie- a mini cushion

Draw peppers using **charcoal**.

Sculpt a pepper from **clay**.

Use **oil pastels** to draw cross sections or whole fruit and vegetables.

Paint images of fruit and vegetables in the style of **Caravaggio**.
