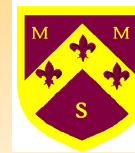

Harvest is celebrated by Christians around the World.

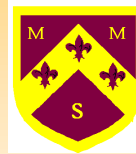

Sukkot



Key Vocabulary

Sukkot-the name of the **festival** of booths/ tabernacles

Sukkah– the **Hebrew [Jewish]** word for booth or tabernacle.

Key Questions

Why is Sukkot important to Jews?

How and why do Jews celebrate Sukkot?

What similarities and differences are there between Harvest and Sukkot?



Key Content

Sukkah is the **Hebrew** word for booth or tabernacles.

Sukkot is the name of the **festival of booths or tabernacles**.

The sukkah is a hut in which **Jews** lived during their years living in the desert after they **left slavery** in Egypt and before they arrived in the **Promised Land [Israel]**

Sukkot is a Jewish holiday celebrated on 15th day of the month of **Tishrei** [this varies from late September to late October]

Sukkot comes at the end of the **High Holidays** which are the most serious days of the Jewish year.

Sukkot is a joyful festival and one of the **Three Pilgrimage Festivals**. It comes straight after **Yom Kippur**.
