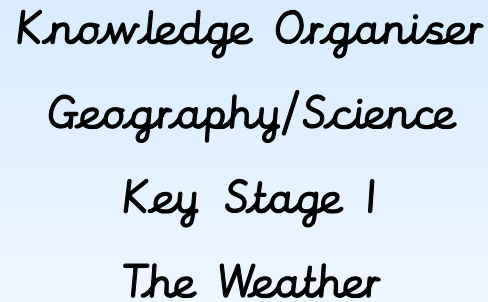




How does the weather change with the seasons?

Key Content and Vocabulary

There are many different types of weather for example: *rainy, sunny, windy, cloudy, snow, sleet, drizzle, hail, thunder.*

The **weather patterns** are different in each season. There are 4 **seasons**. **Spring**: March, April, May **Summer**: June, July, August **Autumn**: September, October, November **Winter**: December, January, February

Climate - the typical weather of a country. In the UK we have a **temperate climate** which means it does not get too hot or too cold.

A **weather forecast** is a statement saying what the weather will be like today, the next day or for the next few days.

Weather forecasts use different **symbols** which are helpful.

Some countries in the world are very hot and others are very cold. Hot countries are located near the equator.

You can record the **temperature** using a **thermometer** to see how hot or cold it is.
