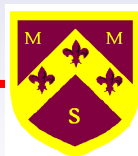

Key Content

We need to follow simple rules to keep safe in our **homes**, on the **road**, near **railways** and when out in the **sun** and **online**.

Warning signs tell us that something is **dangerous**.

We need to make **safe, not risky choices** to keep ourselves and others safe.

There are people in the **community** who we can ask for help e.g. our parents, our teachers, the **emergency services** [police, doctors, nurses, fire fighters]
